

Pursuant to adjournment the Corporation of the township of Ross met in the Town-hall, Colden, on the third day of June 1871 - A full Council present. The Reeve presiding. The minutes of the last sitting of Council were read by the clerk, and signed by the Reeve.

1 Moved by Robert Peilly. Seconded by Dawson Elliott that Joseph Morley Senr. be and he is hereby appointed Pound Keeper for this current year - Carried

2 Moved by Dawson Elliott and seconded by Robert Peilly that the Township Clerk Elliott receive an order on Treasurer for \$30⁰⁰ being for part of salary for the present year - 1871
Carried -

3 Moved by Dawson Elliott & seconded by William Ross that Mr John Doran receive an order on Treasurer for the sum of \$ 227.62. The said sum having been wrongfully assessed against his property. - Carried -

4 Dawson Elliott gave notice that he would at the present sitting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of regulation of lawful fences and also for regulation of Pound Keepers Fees and for the purpose prohibiting certain cattle from running at large

5 Moved by D Elliott seconded by Mr Ross that Bylaw No 144 be read a first second and third time. Short and passed
Carried
It was read a first, second, and third times and passed according to the above resolutions

6 Moved by William Ross and seconded by Robert
Rilly that thirty dollars be granted for the purpose
of being expended on the Queen's road between the
1st and second proving line - Carried

7 Moved by Robert Rilly and seconded by
William Ross that Samuel Rankin receive an
order on the Treasurer for the sum of two
dollars for sawing the bridge between No 16 & No.
17 in the 6th Concession in the Township of Ross.
- Carried -

8 Moved by Elliott seconded by John Hill
that Francis Guest & John Jeffrey be allowed
by this Council to perform three years Statute
labour on the line near their houses. The
work to be examined by the Pathmaster. Carried

9 Moved by Dawson Elliott & seconded by
John Hill that this Council do now adjourn
until the last Saturday in August 1871
