

Ross Council 26<sup>th</sup> Aug. 1871

The Corporation of the Township of Ross met at the Town hall, Cobden, on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, pursuant to adjournment. All the members of the Corporation present. The Reeve, in the Chair. Minutes of former meeting were read and confirmed the Reeve signing the same.

Mr. Reilly gave notice that, that he will at the next meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of levying and collecting a tax to meet the liabilities and expenses of the Corporation for the year 1871

Moved by Mr. Ross, seconded by Robert Reilly that the Trustees of School Section No 2 receive an order on Treasurer for the amount of Joseph Wall's school tax for the year 1871 (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Ross, seconded by Robert Reilly that an order be granted on the Treasurer for the sum of \$3.00 for expenses ~~also~~ in connection with the Poll on the Kingston & Pembroke Railroad Bylaw - Carried

Moved by Robert Reilly, seconded by Mr. Ross that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the amount of \$3.37 to pay the Victoria Mutual Fire Insurance Company - Carried

The Trustees of School Sections No 1, 2, & 8 respectively requested the Council to levy & collect the following sums for school purposes. Viz.

Moved by Robert Reilly & Seconded by William Ross that Thomas Seaton Esq receive an order on Treasurer for the sum of \$20<sup>00</sup> for the purpose of defending the case between Mrs. Nevill & this Corporation Carried
