Moved by Robert Reilly & seconded by John Hill that Bylaw 148 be brought forward and read a second & third time short and passed Carried

The aforesaid Bylaw was read a first, second, and third time short & passed in conformity with the above resolutions —

Moved by Robert Reilly seconded by John Hill that John Reynolds receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$30⁰⁰ for assessing the Township for the year 1872 Carried —

Moved by William Ross seconded by John Hill that an order be drawn in favour of the auditors for three dollars each Carried

Moved by William Ross seconded by John Hill that an order be granted in favour of Thomas Elliott for thirty dollars for his services as clerk for part of the year 1872 Carried

Moved by William Ross & seconded by Robert Pelly that Thomas Elliott be allow'd three years Statute Labour to be performed on the Concession line west of his residence - - Carried

Moved by William Ross & seconded by Robert Pelly that an order be granted to William Wallace Sen^r for ten dollars to pay expenses in going to Pembroke as W^{rs}nefs in the case of Novil & the Corporation (Carried)

Moved by Robert Pelly seconded by John Hill that this Council do now adjourn until the first Saturday in August - Carried
