Ross Council 1st March 1873

Pursuant to adjournment the Council of
the Township of Ross met at the Town-hall, Cobden,
on the 1st day of March 1873

The following were present John Marshall Reeve,
John Hill Esq., John Graff, Robert Rilly,

The Reeve presiding

Minutes of former Meeting were read and confirmed
the Reeve signing the same.

Petitions from Erastus Huntington, Mr. Hill,
and John W. Crawford, were read, praying the Council to
grant to each of the aforesaid a certificate to obtain a
license to keep a house of public entertainment in the
Township of Ross, for the year 1873 & until 1st March
1874.

A certificate for each of the aforesaid applicants was
handed in from the inspector of licenses for Township of Ross
that the said Erastus Huntington, Mr. Hill, & John W. Crawford,
had all the qualifications required by law & the By-
laws of the Corporation of Ross. Consequently had a
right to obtain a certificate each to obtain a license
to keep Tavern or house of entertainment as aforesaid

Moved by Robt. Rilly & seconded by John Graff that John W. Crawford ^(house of public entertainment in Cobden for 1873) receive a certificate to obtain a license to keep a

Moved by Robert Reilly & seconded by John Hill that Bylaw No 154 be brought up and read the second, & third time shot and passed - Carried
The aforesaid Bylaw was read a first, second, & third time shot & passed in conformity with the above resolutions.

Moved by Robert Reilly & seconded by John Hill that Bylaw No 153 for opening the proving line between lots No 5 & 6 to the full breadth or 66 feet be brought up and read a first time Carried

Moved by Robert Reilly and seconded by John Graff that Bylaw No 103 be brought up and read the second & third time shot and passed
The said Bylaw was read a first, second and third time, shot and passed according to the above resolutions.

Moved by John Graff and seconded by Robert Reilly that the Commissioner be and he is hereby instructed to give the job of building a bridge on the proving line between lots 15 and 16 in the 8th Concession said bridge to be completed on or before the 1st day of March next - Carried

Moved by John Graff seconded by John Hill that Mr John Reynolds receive an order on the Treasurer for \$66.45. Thirty five dollars thereof being for part pay as a person & collector for 1872 \$31.45 being for collecting school sections rates for 1872
Carried

Moved by Robert Reilly & seconded by John Hill that
John Hebric Jun^r be appointed Pound Keeper for this
current year (1873) - Carried (Tavern license for 1874)

Moved by Robt. Reilly seconded by John Graff that ^{Ernesto Johnston & John Hill receive a certificate each to obtain, as}
William M. Laren be appointed Pathmaster
for this current year - Carried

Moved by Robert Reilly & seconded by John
Hill that the Clerk (Thos. Elliott) receive an order
on Treasurer for the sum of three dollars for
postage for 1873 (Carried)

Moved by Robert Reilly & seconded by John
Hill that John Reynolds be appointed assessor
and collector for this year & that his salary
be \$8500 Carried

Moved by John Graff and seconded by
Robert Reilly that this Council do now
adjourn to meet again at the Town hall,
Cohden, on the first Saturday in May
next at the hour of ten o'clock A.M.
