

Town-hall, Golden 6th September 1873 P

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met at the Town Hall, Golden on the 6th day of September 1873. The Reeve and all the Councillors present. The Reeve presiding.

Minutes of former meeting were read and confirmed the Reeve signing the same.

Dawson Elliott gives notice that he will at the present meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of levying a rate to defraying the expences of the Corporation of the Township of Ross for the year 1873 P

Moved by Robert Rully and seconded by John Graff that Bylaw No 150 be brought up and read a first time Carried

Moved by John Graff & seconded by Dawson Elliott that the Bylaw just read be read a second and third time short & passed Carried

A Petition signed by ^{nine} ninety electors of the Township of Ross. was read. Said petition required that a Poll be taken in the terms of the "License act of 1868" to determine whether or not the qualified Municipal Electors of said Municipality will adopt under authority and for enforcement of said act, a Bylaw prohibiting the license and sale of intoxicating liquors in shops and houses of public entertainment in this Municipality

Moved by Dawson Elliott seconded by John Graff that a Bylaw for prohibiting the retail of spirituous fermented or other manufactured liquors in the Township of Ross be brought up and read a first time Lost

Moved in amendment by Robert Reilly & seconded by John Hill that the petition lie over for the new Council next year carried

Moved by Robert Reilly and seconded by John Graff that the Clerk receive an order on Treasurer for \$6⁰⁰ for making jury list for the year 1873 - carried

Moved by Dawson Elliott and seconded by John Graff that James Mark receive an order on the Treasurer for three dollars for his services as Tavern inspector for the year 1873 carried

Moved by Dawson Elliott and seconded by John Graff that this Council do now adjourn until Saturday the 27th day of December 1873 carried
