Allowed by Dawson Elliott and seconded by John Graff that an order be drawn in favour of Copp Clark and Co, for \$390 for Stationary Carried

Allowed by John Graff seconded by Robert Riley that Robert Allen receive an order for the sum of \$25⁰⁰ for his services as Road Commissioner for 1873 (Carried)

Allowed by John Graff seconded by Dawson Elliott that the Reeve receive an order on Treasurer for the sum of \$9⁰⁰ the amount of his bill Carried

Allowed by John Graff seconded by Robert Riley that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of Thomas Elliott for thirteen dollars, being for postage registering births marriages and deaths for 1873 (Carried)
