year or that he be refunded One dollar  
& fifty cents that he paid over his  
taxes last year. (Carried)

Moved by Robert Reilly and Sec  
by Jas. B. Marshall that the

Widows Church Delabean & Bromley  
be exempt from taxes for the year 1843  
(Carried)

Moved by Jas. B. Marshall & Sec by  
Robert. Reilly that Robert Hill  
be authorized to call on Thomas  
Elliot & deliver up the Books & papers  
belonging to the Municipal Council  
Carried

Moved by Jas. B. Marshall and seconded  
by Jno Cartman that this Council do  
now adjourn to meet on the last Saturday  
in February at the hour of 10. O'clock.
