that proper notice be given in the Pembroke News-
paper for the establishing of a Public Road
between the road known as Goulds line and the
2nd Concession of Ross said Road to be Sixty
Six feet wide. "Carried".

On Motion of Mr Elliott seconded by Mr
McCaskey that this Council take no action on
the Petition of Delorima Browns respecting
the Church property at Fountains Falls "Carried".

On Motion of Mr Elliott seconded by Mr McCaskey
that the Petition of Oliver Forester & others be
laid over until the next meeting of Council

Mr Elliott gives notice that he will at the present sitting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of authorizing the Trustees of School Section No 4 Sp. of Ross to raise by way of loan the sum of \$700.00 for the purpose of building a school house in said section. Carried.

On motion of Mr Elliott seconded by Mr McCaskill that By Law No 2 be brought up and read the second & third time short & passed.
Carried.

Council legally establish the same road as a
highway. Carried.
