Moved by James Wark and seconded by Robert Keilley that by Law No 1 be brought up and read a second time and the Blank be filled with the sum of \$20.⁰⁰ the second Blank to be filled with the sum of \$40.⁰⁰ and then read a third time short and passed.

(carried) Moved by James Wark and seconded by James B Marshall that a certificate be given to Patrick Wainock, John W. Crawford, and Thomas Hill to get their licence by complying with the law (carried)

Moved by James Wark and seconded by Robert Keilley that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the amount of one Dollar and sixty cents to be paid to the trustees of S. S. No 2. (carried)

Moved by James Wark and seconded by Robert Keilley that the commissioner be sent to inspect the Bridge named in Francis Edwards' Petition and Report to this Council at the next sitting (carried)

Moved by Robert Keilley and seconded by John Cartman that Robert Allen receive an Order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$3.⁵⁰ for sending the Surveyor and dinners. (carried)

Moved by James Wark and seconded by John Cartman that an order be drawn on Treasurer for the sum of \$50.⁰⁰ the amount due as Councillors fees for 43. \$10.⁰⁰ each (carried)

Moved by James B Marshall and seconded by John Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of Twelve Dollars to be Paid to the Editor of the Lynbroke Observer. (carried)

Seconded by John Cartman that
John Marshall Receive an Order on the
Treasurer for the Sum of \$3⁰⁰ for Wood
(Carried)

Moved by Robert Keilley and Seconded
by James B Marshall that James Levings
Receive an Order on the Treasurer for the
Sum of \$1.50 for Statute Labour over done
(Carried)

Moved by James Work and Seconded by
John Cartman that the Treasurer be instructed
to pay Mr Allen the Surveyor the amount
of fifteen Dollars for his services Surveying
the line from the lake to the Government
Road (Carried)

Order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour
of James B Marshall for the Sum of
\$3⁰⁰ as pay for his services as Councillor
for two days (Carried)
