John Hill that By Law No 2 be brought up
and read a second & third time short
and passed (Carried)
It was read a First Second and Third time
short and passed according to the aforesaid
Resolution
Moved by John Hill and seconded by John
Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer
in favour of John Reynolds for the sum of Ninety

Dollars and Fifty Eight Cents amount due
him for collecting Taxes (Carried)

Moved by James Wark and Seconded by
John Cartman that Robert Allen be instructed
to let a job of building a new bridge on the
Road to Boyces Mill (Carried)
