Moved by Mr. Reilly seconded by Mr. Wark that John Cartman do his Statute Labour on the Sixth con<sup>ty</sup> (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Wark seconded by Mr. Cartman that David Reeve gets four years Statute Labour on the Proving Line between Lots Nos 15 & 16 the Labour to be all done in the year 1874 (Carried)

The Council then adjourned unto 1 o'clock.

Pursuant to adjournment the Council met at one o'clock all the members present.

Moved by Mr. Wark seconded by Mr. Cartman that Robert Ellen and John Reynolds be employed by this Council to investigate lands that are advertised for sale for nonpayment of Taxes
