which the aforesaid William S. Coleman Esqr

formed themselves into a Council for the trans-

that Robert Hill be appointed Clerk of this Municipality
for the current year at a salary of Sixty five
dollars. (Carried)

third time short and passed according to the

in the Township of Ross for the present
year. Moved by John Graff & seconded
by Mr Hill that by law No 2 be brought
up and read a first time. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Hill & seconded by Mr Cartman
that By Law No 2 be brought up the first
blank be filled with twenty dollars and the
second blank with forty dollars then read
