the 27th day of February A.D. 1875

Pursuant to adjournment the Council of the
Corporation of Ross met in the Town Hall
at Ross February 27th 1875 all the members
present except Robert Hill.

Minutes of former meeting were read
approved of and signed by the Reeve
Petitions from Patrick Warnock

J. Hobbin Mrs Hill & Robert W. Crawford
were read praying that the Council would
grant them a Certificate to obtain
a Tavern License for the present year
Mr Cartman gives notice that he will
at the present sitting of Council introduce
a by law for the purpose of fixing the
amounts of Tavern and Shop license fees
in the Township of Ross for the present
year. Moved by John Graff & seconded
by Mr Hill that by law No 2 be brought
up and read a first time. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Hill & seconded by Mr Cartman
that By Law No 2 be brought up the first
blank be filled with twenty dollars and the
second blank with forty dollars then read

second & third time short & passed according
to the above Resolution

Town Hall Cobden May 1st

Pursuant adjournment the Municipal
Council of the Township of Ross met in the
Town Hall Cobden May 1st 1845 all the
members present except Mr Hill. Minutes
of former meeting were read approved of
and signed by the Revere. Petitions were
read from the Trustees of School Sections Nos
1, 7 & 9 praying the Council to pass a by
Law to authorize them to borrow money to
build School Houses in the aforesaid Sections
in S. S. No 1 \$400⁰⁰ in S. S. No 7 \$900⁰⁰
and in S. S. No 9 \$850⁰⁰.

Mr Reilly gives notice that he will intro-
duce a by Law for the purpose of authorizing
the Trustees of School Sections Nos 1 7 & 9
to borrow by way of loan the following
sums viz No 1 \$400⁰⁰ No 7 \$900⁰⁰ and No
9 \$850⁰⁰.
