Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal
Council of the Township of Ross met in the
Town Hall Cobden on the 14th day of August.

The Reeve and all the Councillors present
except Mr. Hill; Minutes of former meeting,
were read approved of and signed by the
Reeve; a letter was read from Bromley
Council requesting the Council of Ross
to expend the sum of \$20.⁰⁰ on Town Line
between Ross & Bromley they having laid
out an equivalent to that.

Moved by Mr. Reilly seconded by Mr. Geoff.
that the sum of \$15.⁰⁰ be granted to repair
the Road between Lots 15 & 16. in the 4th Concession
of Ross. (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Reilly seconded by Mr.
Cartman that the sum of \$20.⁰⁰ be granted
on the Town Line between Ross and Bromley,
to commence at Alsted's Corner thence
downwards across W^m McDunn's lot. (Carried)
Robert Reilly gave notice that he would
at this sitting of ^{Council} introduce a By Law
for the purpose of levying a rate to meet
the expences of the current Year.

Moved by Mr. Reilly seconded by Mr.
Cartman that By Law No 8 for the purpose
of levying the Township rates be brought up
and read the first time (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Reilly seconded by
Mr. Cartman that By Law No 8 be brought
up and the first blank be filled with \$2,330.⁰⁰
and the second blank filled with 1st in the dollar
they read a second & third time short & passed

Moved by Mr. Reilly seconded by Mr. Carlman that By Law No. 9 be brought up and read the first time. (Carried)

Moved by John Carlman seconded by Mr. Reilly that By Law No. 9 be brought up and read the second and third time short and passed. (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Graff seconded by Mr. Reilly that the Petition of Mr. Roach and others be Granted to open up the second concession line between lots 18 & 21 and that the Road Commissioner be instructed to see what it would cost to open up said line and to let the contract of opening the said Road. (Carried)

Mr. Reilly gives notice that he will at this sitting of Council introduce a By Law to Levy a rate on School Sections Nos. 8 & 9 in the Township of Ross. (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Carlman seconded by Mr. Reilly that By Law No. 10 be brought up and read the first time. (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Reilly seconded by Mr. Graff that By Law No. 10 be brought up and read the second and third time short and passed. (Carried)

The aforesaid By Law was read a first second and third time short and passed according to the above Resolution. Moved by Robert Reilly seconded by Mr. Carlman that this Council
