Moved in Amendment by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Black that Edward Bulmer be appointed by this Council to the Office of Treasurer for 1876 at a salary of forty dollars. (Lost)

Moved by John Graff and seconded by Mr Cartman that John Reynolds be appointed Assessor and Collector for this Municipality for the year 1876 for the sum \$55.⁰⁰ (Carried)

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Black that James Galt Esqr be appointed to the Office of Auditor for this Township for

the Year 1876 (Carried)

The Reeve appointed Daniel Ledgerwood as the other Auditor for 1876 with James Graft

Moved by Mr Elliott - seconded by Mr Cartman that Edward Bulmer be appointed Tavern Inspector for the T^p. of 1876 (Carried)

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Graft that Robert Riley be appointed Road Commissioner for the expenditure of Money on Roads in this Municipality for the Year 1876 (Carried)

Mr Elliott gives notice that he will introduce during the present sitting of Council a By Law for the purpose of appointing Township Officers for the Year 1876.

Moved by Mr Elliott - seconded by Mr Cartman that By Law No 1 for the purpose of appointing Township officers for 1876 be brought up and read a first time. (Carried)

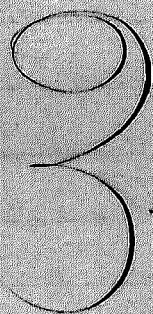
