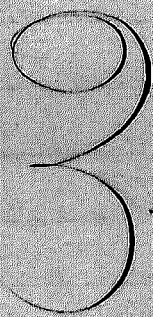

On motion of Mr Black seconded by Mr Elliot that this Council hold their meetings alternately at Foresters Falls next meeting to be at Foresters Falls in the School House. (Carried)

On motion of Mr Graff seconded by Mr Cartman that Mr Robert Bulmer be requested by this Council to put ten days labor this year on the Proven Line along the side of Mr Corn^s Lot at such places as he Mr Bulmer thinks most necessary. (Carried)
