the 15th day of April A.D. 1876

Pursuant to Adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the School House Ffester Falls, the Reeve William S. Coleman Esq being absent, the Councillors Messrs George Black Tho^s Elliott John Cartman and John Geaff formed themselves into a Council.

It was moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Black that Mr Geaff take the Chair in the absence of the Reeve W^m S. Coleman Esq. (Carried)

Minutes of former Meeting were read approved of and signed by the Chairman

Petitions were read from James Grant Sen^r praying the Council would grant a sum sufficient to build a Bridge, ^{across} a gully on the 10th Concession line of the T^w of Ross Petitioner having no other

way to get in or out from his place
Petitioners from J. H. Gould and
other Praying the Council would grant
the sum of 50.⁰⁰/₁₁ to open up a Road from
Colden Station to the Town Line between
Ross & Bromley, Bromley Council opens up
the remainder of said Road.

also a Petition from Malcolm Morrison
and others praying the Council would open
up the 6th Concession Line between Lots 10 & 11
to the Government Road

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Cartman that Council do grant the sum of ten dollars the Council of Westmeath having granted a like sum both sums to be expended on the Town line between Ross & Westmeath & that Alex^r Fraiser expend the same. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Elliott that ten dollars be granted to repair the Road leading to Bruce's Settlement (Carried)

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Black that the sum of fifty dollars be expended on the Proving line between 10 & 11 leading from the 6th Concession to the Government Road. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Black seconded by Mr Cartman that Robert Murdoch Jun get permission from this Council to perform two years Statute labor on the 10th Coⁿ in the off of Ross. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Black
that Mr John Howie Jun be appointed to
the office of Pauid Keeper for this Current
Year. Carried.
