rolls for the Township of Ross for the year 1876.

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr  
Black that the Rolls as returned by the  
assessor for the year 1876, be received and  
passed as fully revised by this Court of  
Revision no Complaints or appeals having  
been made. Carried.

The Municipal Council of the  
Township of Ross then commenced the  
General Township business.

the Reeve. Moved by George Black  
seconded John Cartman that this Court

Moved by Mr Black. Seconded by Mr Elliott. that an order be granted to Paul Morrow on the Treasurer for the sum of \$10.<sup>00</sup> ten dollars for repairing Road on the 12<sup>th</sup> Con<sup>n</sup> of Ross on Road leading to Bruce Settlement. "Carried"

Moved by Mr Black. Seconded by Mr Cartman that Edward Hill be struck of the Assessment Roll and that John Wilson be put in his stead. Carried

Moved by Mr Elliott. Seconded by Mr Cartman. that Mr George Black be authorized to consult with Mr Broom & Mr Byce and settle about the Road in dispute between them "Carried"

Moved by Mr Elliott. Seconded by Mr John Cartman that Mr John Reynolds receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$40.<sup>00</sup> being for assessing the Township for 1876. "Carried"

Moved by Mr Black. Seconded by Mr Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of fifty three Cents in favour of Hart and Rawlins for Stationery, also the amount of two dollars & sixty five Cents to John Marshall for Stationery and Postage. "Carried"

Moved by Mr Cartman. Seconded by Mr Black that James Dunison be appointed Pathmaster in place of Christopher Cozier

who was appointed but did not qualify  
(Carried)

Moved by Mr Black  
Seconded by Mr Elliott that Alex<sup>r</sup> M. Soren  
be appointed Postmaster from Gilchests  
Corner along the Government Road to the  
Town line between Horton & Ross, "Carried"

Moved by Mr Cartman Seconded by Mr  
Black that John Ross be appointed Postmaster  
for Cobden Village in place of William J  
Crawford who has left the place, "Carried"

Moved by Mr Elliott Seconded by Mr  
Black that the sum of fifty dollars  
be granted by this Council for the purpose  
of making a crossway & cutting a ditch on  
1<sup>st</sup> Concession between eighteen and twentyone

"Carried" Moved by Mr Elliott  
Seconded by Mr Cartman that all the  
parties wrought on Proven line for Mr  
Thomas M<sup>r</sup> See on last year be authorized  
to do the same this year "Carried"

Moved by Mr Elliott Seconded by Mr  
Cartman that Mr Coleman be authori-  
-zed to give two dollars per month until  
the 1<sup>st</sup> of January next to John Paterson  
he being old and infirm, "Carried"

Moved by Mr Elliott Seconded by  
Mr Black that the Road Commis-  
-sioner be instructed to give a job on  
the ~~first~~<sup>second</sup> Concession between Lots  
18 & 21. Said job not to exceed fifty  
dollars, "Carried"

Moved by Mr Elliott Seconded by  
Mr Cartman that this Council Petition the Hon<sup>ble</sup>  
A. B. Foster to place the rail Road Station  
on or near the proving line between Nos 5 & 6 on Mr Brown  
or Mr Goulds property. (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Black Seconded by Mr. Cartman  
that Robert Hill receive an order on the  
Treasurer for the sum of \$ 37.<sup>50</sup> part salary  
for 1876 (Carried)

Moved by Mr. Black Seconded by Mr.  
Elliott that this Council do now adjourn  
to meet on the third Saturday in August  
at Foresters Falls at the hour of 10 O'clock  
A.M. (Carried)
