

Cobden August 11<sup>th</sup> 1877

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall Cobden on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August 1877

Councillors all present.

The Revere presiding

Minutes of former meeting were read approved of and signed by The Revere & Clerk

Moved by Thomas Wallace seconded by J. Elliott that the sum of thirty dollars be expended by this Council in the repairing of the Town line between Ross & Westmeath commencing at Sheretts Corner and ending at Zion Church on condition of Westmeath Council granting a like sum for the aforesaid purpose and that John Howie Jr expend the same if Westmeath Council agree thereto. Carried.

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Wallace that Mr Allen Lind Surveyor be employed by this Council to survey a Road commonly called the blank line near Mr Michell Gormans place and run a legal line so that the said line may be ascertained. Carried.

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Wallace that John Howie Commissioner let a job of building a bridge on the Proving line near Widow Wilcox's Residence and that he take proper bonds for the due performance of the same works. Carried.

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr McCaskie that Isaac Howard & Mrs Howard be allowed their Statute labor for the ensuing year to <sup>make</sup> a water course & other improvements near a bridge on the Proving line near their Residence. Carried.

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr McCastile  
that the sum of two Hundred and thirty dollars  
be levied and collected from the rateable property  
of the School Section No 8 for public school  
purposes by order of the Trustees of said section  
for said purposes. "Carried"

Also that the sum of two Hundred dollars  
be levied & collected from all the rateable property  
of school section No 9 being for public school  
purposes by order of Trustees of said section. "Carried"

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Hills  
that those persons who are building fences  
on the 6<sup>th</sup> Co<sup>rs</sup> near lot No 1 Sp. of Ross  
be notified to remove said fences & leave the  
entire breadth of said road or they will be  
prosecuted according to law. Carried

Mr Elliott gives Notice that he will at  
the present Meeting of Council introduce a  
By law fixing the amount of Township rates  
to be raised to meet the expenses of the Pop  
Corporation for the current year.

Moved by Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Mc  
Castile that Bylaw No 4 for the purpose  
of levying the sum of 3 Mills in the \$ to meet  
the expenses of the Corporation of Ross for the  
current year be brought up and read the  
first time. "Carried"

Moved by Mr McCastile seconded Mr Wallace  
that Bylaw No 4 be brought up and the  
blanks filled in with 3 Mills in the \$ then read  
a second & third time short and passed. "Carried"

the Aforesaid bylaw was read a first second  
& third time short & passed according to the above  
Resolutions.

Moved by Mr Elliott - seconded by Mr Wallace that an order be drawn in favour of John Marshall for Stationery & Postage to the 10<sup>th</sup> August 1877 for the sum of \$3.93. Carried.

Moved by Mr Elliott - seconded by Mr Wallace that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the second Saturday of October next at Foresters Falls at the hour of 10 o'clock in the forenoon of said day. Carried.

The Council then adjourned for one hour after the expiration of one hour the Council met - all the members present.

On Motion of Mr Elliott - seconded by Mr Wallace that the Clerk give the legal notice that the Ross Council intends at its next meeting to pass a by law to establish a fore Road surveyed by James Allen P.L.S. No 10.11712 in the 11<sup>th</sup> cor<sup>r</sup> of the Township of Ross according to a plan furnished by the said James Allen P.L.S. Carried.
