Pursuant to adjournment the  
Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met  
in the Town Hall Cobden on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of  
December 1879. all the members present  
The Revere presiding.

Minutes of former meeting

On Motion of Mr. Elliott Seconded by Mr.  
McCastill that one hundred dollars be taken

from Mr John McDonalds personal property  
as he was assessed said amount by a mistake.

On Motion of Mr Elliott Secouded by Mr  
Wallace that the personal property charged on the  
assessment roll against No 2 of 10 in the 8<sup>th</sup> Co<sup>th</sup> viz  
\$100<sup>00</sup> be struck off the Collectors Roll. The owner  
Mrs Faught - having no right to pay the same. Carried.

On Motion of Mr Elliott Secouded by Mr McCaskie  
that an order be drawn in favour of the Trustees of S. S.  
No 6 Ross for \$7.<sup>00</sup> due on lot No 40 in the 9<sup>th</sup> Co<sup>th</sup> there  
being no property on said lands. Carried.

On Motion of Mr Elliott Secouded by Mr McCaskie  
that orders be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of the  
Trustees of the following sections viz S. S. No 1 \$52.<sup>20</sup>

& Co James Tierney \$19.<sup>00</sup> for building a Bridge  
Wm. C. Collins \$20.<sup>00</sup> for work on roads S. E  
Mitchell for Collectors Receipts \$1.<sup>08</sup> Patrick  
Ratchford \$8.<sup>00</sup> for work done on a Bridge George  
Coudray \$10.<sup>00</sup> and that orders be drawn  
on the Treasurer for the same. Carried.

On Motion of Mr Hill Secouded by Mr Wallace that the line commonly known as the Gozmau line in this Township having for the last ten or fifteen years been a matter of dispute between the parties residing thereon

and whereas the same has been at different times before this Council and is yet unsettled.

therefore be it Resolved that the Revere of this Township be and is hereby authorized and instructed by this Council to apply to the County Council at its first session asking the said County Council to make an application to the Lieutenant-Governor of Ontario requesting him to cause the said line to be surveyed and marked by permanent boundaries under the direction and order of the Commissioner of Crown Lands, as provided in the 93<sup>rd</sup> Chapter and 6<sup>th</sup> Section of the Consolidated Statutes of Upper Canada Respecting Concession Lines and parts of Concession lines, that have become obliterated and which are in dispute between parties residing thereon, and that this Council levy the Costs incurred on the Residents of the part of said line who are interested therein,

as by the said Statute provided. Carried

On Motion of Mr Elliott Secouded by Mr Hill that By law No 5 for establishing a road between the 2<sup>nd</sup> Concession and Goulds Road be read a first time. Carried

On Motion of Mr Elliott Secouded by Mr McLeasvie that By law No 5 for establishing a road between the 2<sup>nd</sup> Concession & Goulds Road be brought up and read a second & third time short and passed. Carried

the said Bylaw was read a first, second and third time short and passed according to the above Resolu

On Motion of Mr Hill Secouded by Mr M<sup>c</sup>Castill that Bylaw No 6 for establishing a force Road across lots No 10, 11, & 12 in the 11<sup>th</sup> Concession of the Sp. of Ross be brought up and read the first time. Carried

On Motion of Mr M<sup>c</sup>Castill Secouded by Mr Hill that Bylaw No 6 for establishing a force Road across lots No 10, 11, & 12 in the 11<sup>th</sup> Concession be brought up and read a second & third time short & passed. Carried

the aforesaid Bylaw was read a first second & third time short & passed according to the above resolutions.

On Motion of Mr M<sup>c</sup>Castill Secouded by Mr Hill that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of Mr James B. Marshall for the sum of \$11.19 being for Taxes charged in a mistake. Carried

On Motion of Mr Elliott Secouded by Mr Hill that an order be drawn in favour of John Reynolds for one dollar for one day on business for Council. Carried

On Motion of Mr Elliott Secouded by Mr M<sup>c</sup>Castill that an order be drawn in favour of Robert Allen for the sum of \$2.00 being for services for overseeing the repairs of a Road near Cobden. Carried

On Motion of Mr M<sup>c</sup>Castill Secouded by Mr Hill that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of Thomas Heaton M. P. P. for the sum of \$10.00 being for legal advice. Carried

On Motion of Mr Hill Secouded by Mr M<sup>c</sup>Castill that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of Robert Hill for the sum of \$32.50 being for balance of Salary for 1871. Carried

On Motion of Mr McCaskill seconded by Mr Elliott that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of George Black for the sum of \$12.<sup>50</sup> for having legal advice and expenses. Carried.

On Motion of Mr Elliott seconded by Mr Wallace that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of the Reeve and Councillors for the following sums being for their services for the year 1877.
