a full Council present - The Reeve presiding  
Minutes of former Meeting were read  
approved & signed by the Reeve & Clerks.

On Motion of Robert Murdoch seconded by  
Thomas Hill that John Reynolds receive an order  
on the Treasurer for the sum of \$45.<sup>00</sup> for collecting  
Taxes for 1877. Carried

On Motion of Mr. Graff seconded by Mr. Murdoch  
that an order be granted on the Treasurer for the  
following amounts money paid out by Treasurer  
for which he has no vouchers viz

Thos<sup>d</sup> Edwards on Roads: \$60.<sup>50</sup> W. A. Coleman for  
Spikes \$4.<sup>40</sup> James Tierney on Roads \$17.<sup>00</sup> John E. Collins  
do \$20.<sup>00</sup> Geo. Cawdry do \$10.<sup>00</sup> Pat Ratchford do \$8.<sup>00</sup>  
S. E. Mitchell for Stationery \$1.<sup>08</sup> Total amount -  
is \$120.<sup>98</sup> Carried

On Motion of Mr. Graff seconded by Mr. Murdoch  
that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of  
Andrew Rose for the sum of \$5.<sup>00</sup> also James Logan  
the sum of \$2.<sup>00</sup> for work done on <sup>the</sup> contract. Carried

On Motion of Mr. Murdoch seconded by Mr. Graff  
that James Bennett - Sr be allowed his Statute Labour  
from his own place out to the Government Road and  
that the Pathmaster of that Section see that the labour  
is performed. Carried

On Motion of Mr. M. Coakill seconded by Mr. Graff  
that John and Thomas Fraser be allowed their Statute  
Labour on a fence line between Ross & Westmeath commencing  
at Government Road and working towards the sixth  
concession line. Carried

On Motion of Mr. Graff seconded by Mr.

M<sup>r</sup> Castill that the sum of \$ 30.<sup>00</sup> be granted towards improving the sixth line known as the apple Road. Carried

On Motion of M<sup>r</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Castill seconded by M<sup>r</sup> Hill that John Howie Road Commissioner go and examine the concession line between six & seven opposite Mrs Morgans and report the same at the next sitting of Council. Carried

On Motion of M<sup>r</sup> Gruff seconded by Mrs Murdoch that the Reeve be empowered to get the town line between Ross & Bromly surveyed across four lots being nos. 9, 10, 11, & 12, and that he notify the Bromly Council to be their share of said survey. Carried

On Motion of M<sup>r</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Castill seconded by Mrs Murdoch that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of School Section No. 7 for the sum of \$ 11.<sup>34</sup> being amount <sup>collected</sup> over and above <sup>paying</sup> coupon. Carried

On Motion of M<sup>r</sup> Murdoch seconded by M<sup>r</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Castill that \$ 10.<sup>00</sup> be granted to repair a Bridge known as M<sup>r</sup> Laughlans Bridge on the Governorment Road. Carried

On Motion of M<sup>r</sup> Gruff seconded by Mrs M<sup>r</sup> Castill that Morris Power be appointed Pathmaster in place of Thomas Power. Carried

On Motion of M<sup>r</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Castill seconded by M<sup>r</sup> Gruff that the Town Hall be given for all Religious Services & that the Hall be kept clean, and that John Delaney receive the Key for keeping and that he charge all shows and such like from two to three dollars according to his judgment. Carried

On Motion of M<sup>r</sup> Murdoch seconded by M<sup>r</sup> Gruff that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of Edward Gibson for the sum of \$ 14.<sup>00</sup> being the amount of his contract. Carried

On Motion of Mr Hill seconded by Mr Muddock  
that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour  
of John Delaney & W.A. Coleman for the sum  
of \$4.<sup>00</sup> each for their services as auditors for  
auditing the Township Accounts for 1878. Carried

On Motion of Mr Muddock seconded by Mr  
Hill that this Council do now adjourn to meet  
again at the Town Hall Cobden on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday  
in July 1878 then meet as a Court of Revision  
and also for general business of the Township. Carried

that \$10.<sup>00</sup> be expended on the Iron line between Ross  
& Westmeath at that part known as the Wilson Settle  
ment providing that Westmeath grant the same amount. Carried

On Motion of Mr McEaskie seconded by Mr Muddock  
that John Howie go and see what improvements is required  
to be done on fifth Concession of Ross between 10 & 11 and  
let some Coadys same jobs not to exceed \$10.<sup>00</sup>. Carried
