Minutes of former meeting were read approved of and signed by the Reeve & Clerk

Petitions were received from School Section Nos 26, 4, 8, 9 asking the Council to levy upon the Collector's Roll for general school purposes the following amounts viz \$240.⁰⁰ for No 9 and 145.⁰⁰ for No 2 and \$20.⁰⁰ for No 6 and \$752.⁰⁰ for No 7

Moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by Mr Graff that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of Robert Blair for the sum of Twelve dollars for work done on Roads. Carried

Moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by Mr McCastill that the Road Commissioner be instructed to give out a job on the Road between Mrs Arge Blacks and Morris Bridge to the amount of \$10.⁰⁰

Mr Murdoch gives notice that he will at the present meeting of Council introduce a By law for the purpose of levying a Township & County Rate for the year 1898

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr McCastill that by law for levying County and township rates be now brought up and read the first time

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr McCastill that the by law for levying rates be brought up and read the second time and that the first blank be filled in with the words - two thousand two hundred and nineteen and sixty six cents and the second blank be filled in with the word ten

Carried

Moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by Mr Hill that by law for levying the township and county rates be now brought up and read the third time short and passed. Carried

Moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by Mr Hill that an order be drawn on the treasurer in favor of George Marshall for the sum of \$30.00 being part salary for assessing the township for the year 1878 Carried

Mr McEaskill gives notice that he will at the present sitting of council introduce a by-law for the purpose of stating the amt to be paid for levying and collecting school monies in the Township of Ross for 1878

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr McEaskill that by law no 4 for the purpose of stating the percentage to be paid by school sections for levying and collecting school rates in the Township of Ross be brought up and read the first time Carried

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr McEaskill that by law no 4 for the purpose of stating the amt to be paid by school sections for levying and collecting the general school monies be brought up and the blank filled in with the words one percent on the dollar then read a second and third time short and passed Carried

Moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by Mr Graff that an order be drawn on the treasurer in favor of George David Black for the sum of four dollars 4.00 for saving a bridge from burning on Grants Creek - Carried

Moved by Mr McEaskill seconded by Mr Murdoch that this Council do now adjourn to meet at the Town Hall in Cobden on the first Saturday in September next at the hour of ten O'clock Am. Carried
