

Cobden September 7th 1878

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall Cobden on Saturday the 7th day of September 1878

a full Council present

The Reeve presiding

Minutes of former meeting were read approved of and signed by the Reeve & Clerk

On Motion of Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. McCastille that Thomas Smith be exempt from Statute Labor for 1878. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. McCastille seconded by Mr. Murdock that James Ferguson receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$30.⁰⁰ for building a bridge and cutting down Hill on Peop line between 10 & 11. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. ~~McCastille~~^{Will} seconded by Mr. McCastille that Richard Richards receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.⁵⁰ for work done on Crossway at the head of Mustirat Lane. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. McCastille that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of John Delahay for the sum of Sixty Seven Cents being for one Chair for Town Hall. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. McCastille seconded by Mr. Murdock that the Reeve be authorized to notify David Gibson to remove any obstructions ^{in front} he has put on the Road ^{between} as the fifth concession. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. McCastille that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Edward Jeffrey for the sum of \$10.⁰⁰ being for Expences Paid by him in procuring a Seed from James Gould for the Road leading from the Railway Station to Cobden

to the Town line between Ross and Bromley. Carried.

On Motion of Mr Murdock seconded by Mr Hill that eight dollars more be granted to repair main street abutment from Town Hall to Railway Station. Carried.

On Motion of Mr Murdock seconded by Mr M. Castile that the Reeve get an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$3.²⁵ for expenses as health officer. Carried.

On Motion of Mr Murdock seconded by Mr Hill that the Corporation pay John Graft the sum of six dollars for law expenses and three dollars for time. Carried.

On Motion of Mr M. Castile seconded by Mr Hill that this Council do now adjourn to meet again at Foresters Falls on the first Saturday in November. Carried.
