1st Moved by John Graff seconded by

of the Town Chrd. "Carried"

2nd Moved by Mr Murdock seconded by Mr M^{urdock}
that the prayer of the Petition Daniel Lurey and
others be granted with regard to separation of
School Section 2101. Carried

3rd Moved by Mr Murdock seconded by Mr Cook
that Thomas Smith be exempt from tax for
the year 1878. Carried

4th Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Murdock
that the Clerk be instructed to give notice to the
parties concerned with the blank line between the
fifth and sixth concessions be notified personally
to move all obstructions of the Road, allowance
that is commencing at the Town line between
Aborton and Ross and leaving off at the Proving
line between lots 20 and 21 all to be moved
in or before the first day of May next

and also that the Clerk put up three public notices in public places to the above effect. Carried.
5th Moved by Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. Cook that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of John Howie for the sum of \$1.00 for going to Cobden to give out a job on the Hill at Cobden. Carried.

6th Moved by Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. McCaskill that William McLaughlin be struck off the Pathmasters List and Patrick Rasthoford be inserted in his stead. Carried.

7th Moved by Mr. Cook seconded by Mr. Murdock that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$7.97 being school taxes on the South half of lot 16 on the 8th concession of the Township of Ross. Carried.

8th Moved by Mr. Cook seconded by Mr. Murdock that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Francis Edwards for the sum of \$1.00 for Road arbitrator. Carried.

9th Moved by Mr. McCaskill seconded by Mr. Murdock that James Johnston & Delina Brown pathmasters do expend part of their Statute Labour on their lists on the road leading to Cobden commencing at Government Road. Carried.

10th Moved by Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. McCaskill that John Howie be appointed Road Commissioner for the incoming year for the sum of \$1.00. Carried.

11th Moved by Mr. Cook seconded by Mr. Murdock that the Clerk be instructed to give notice to the Trustees of School Section No 1 that the separation of this School Section is about to take place. Carried.

12th Moved by Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. Cook that John Wilson receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.00 for arbitrator on his at Lemington. Carried.

- 13th Moved by Mr. Cook seconded by Mr. Murdock that the Petition of Francis Edwards and others be granted that the road be made in the tenth Concession. Carried.
- 14th moved by Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. McEashill that the Steward's office receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$10.00 for printing minutes of Council. Carried.
- 15th moved by Mr. McEashill seconded by Mr. Murdock that the Collector receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$5.00 for mistake of Tassps on the Concessioned lands. Carried.
- 16th moved by Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. Cook that James Livingston receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$26.⁰⁰ when he furnishes a sufficient bond for road allowance to satisfy Rowe going on to New Stratford on the east side of a marsh by the two arbitrators appointed at the last sitting of Council by Francis Edwards and John Wilson. Carried.
- 17th Moved by Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. McEashill that the Receiver execute a lease of a portion of the land in the village of Cobden to John Wilson. Carried.
- 18th moved by Mr. Cook seconded by Mr. Murdock that a Widow DeLombough be exempt from tax for the year 1875. Carried.
- 19th moved by Mr. Murdock seconded by Mr. Cook that J. N. McDonald's application be left over until next sitting of Council as there is no proof of work being done. Carried.
