Foresters Falls May 31st 1879

Pursuant to notice published in the Pembroke Observer and Standard the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met as a Court of Revision on the aforesaid date for the purpose of Revising the Assessment Rolls for the Township of Ross for the year 1879. after taking the necessary oaths required of a Member of this Court they commenced business there being five appeals which was as follows.

- 1st Thomas Mathison against personal property.
 - 2nd Bruce Morrow. Real property too high should not be assessed for personal
 - 3rd Morris Power. too high assessed improved property.
 - 4th John Warner property too high assessed not Equalized that
 - 5th person could that he is too high assessed.
- after looking the Rolls over it was moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by John Cartman ^{Thos Mathison} that Bruce Morrow and Morris Power's ^{assessments} be passed over and no action taken thereon. Carried
