### Court of Revision.

Foresters Falls May 31<sup>st</sup> 1879

Pursuant to notice published in the Pembroke Observer and Standard the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met as a Court of Revision on the aforesaid date for the purpose of Revising the Assessment Rolls for the Township of Ross for the year 1879. after taking the necessary oaths required of a Member of this Court they commenced business there being five appeals which was as follows.

1<sup>st</sup> Thomas Mathison against personal property.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bruce Morrow. Real property too high should not be assessed for personal

3<sup>rd</sup> Morris Power. too high assessed improved property.

4<sup>th</sup> John Warner property too high assessed not Equalized

5<sup>th</sup> person could that he is too high assessed.

after looking the Rolls over it was moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by John Cartman <sup>Thos Mathison</sup> that Bruce Morrow and Morris Power's assessment be passed over and no action taken thereon. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Murdoch that John C. Harris assessment be reduced 30 per cent. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Murdoch that J. H. Swallow assessment be reduced \$75.00 Carried.

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Murdoch that Miss Threadwell's assessment be raised 30 per cent. Carried.

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr Murdoch that William J. Crawford's millage property be raised five dollars. Carried.

Moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by Mr Graff that the W & B in the 4th case be assessed to Robert Gibson and that the 6% be struck off the Roll. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Murdoch that the Rolls as returned by the assessor be accepted as revised by this Court of Revision with the aforesaid alterations. Carried.

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross then commenced the general business of the Township.

Members all present. The Reeve presiding.

Minutes of former Meeting were read approved of and signed by the Reeve and Clerk.

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Murdoch that Bylaw No 5 for the purpose of opening up the Road between the fifth and sixth Concessions of Ross be now read a second and third time short and passed. Carried.

The bylaw was read a first, second and third time short and passed according to the above resolutions.

Moved by Mr Murdoch seconded by Mr Cook that the motion passed in this Council in favour of Francis Edwards' Petition be rescinded. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Graff that  
auditors Report be accepted by this Council. Carried

Moved by Mr Murdock seconded by Mr Graff  
that Edwards Bulmers Petition be accepted. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Graff  
that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of  
W. Coleman and John Melahy for three dollars each for  
their services as Auditors for 1899. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Murdock that  
John Cartman get his Statute Labor on the Fifth Concession  
for the N.P. in the 5<sup>th</sup> case. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Cartman that Robert  
Hill receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$11.<sup>00</sup>  
being for Election Expenses. Carried

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr Cook that an  
order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of John Hawie  
for the sum of three dollars services as Road Commissioner. Carried

Moved by Mr Murdock seconded by Mr Cook that  
the Widow McNaughton receive one hundred weight of  
flour from this Council. Carried

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr Cartman that  
Robert Murdock receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum  
of two dollars for examining a Road allowance on the tenth  
concession also to examine Pet for Road through Wark's land  
and Bulmers. Carried

Moved by Mr Murdock seconded by Mr Graff that  
George McCastill receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum  
of \$1.50 for looking out Road allowance on tenth concession. Carried

Moved by Mr Murdock seconded by Mr Graff that  
James Wark receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum  
of \$30.<sup>00</sup> in part payment for Road allowance through lot  
1011 in the 9<sup>th</sup> concession. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Murdock that  
this Council do now adjourn to meet again to meet  
again on the last Saturday in June at Cobden Town  
Hall. Carried
