

Cobden Town Hall August 30<sup>th</sup> 1879

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall on the said date. Members all present the Reeve presiding.

Minutes of former meeting were read approved of and signed by the Reeve and Clerk.

Mr. Murdoch gives notice that he will at the present sitting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of opening up the Road known as the Bulmer Road on lots 10 and 11 in the 9<sup>th</sup> concession of the Twp. of Ross.

Moved by Mr. Cook seconded by Mr. Murdoch that <sup>Wm</sup> McFellors Pathmaster be allowed to put his labour & all those on his list on the line between the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Concessions that is commencing at Gaulds Road and working between that and the Proving line between lots 20 and 21 Ross. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Murdoch seconded by Mr. Cook that the Bylaw No. 6 just taken up be published in the Pembrok Standard for four weeks then taken into consideration next meeting of Council. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Murdoch seconded by Mr. Cook that an order be drawn in favour of Mr. Coleman for the sum of \$4.75 being for money paid by him to the Victoria Mutual Fire Insurance Company for the year 1878. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Graff seconded by Mr. Cartman that the job let to James Pever to the amount of \$49.00 sustained by this Council the same to be paid next year in 1880. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Murdoch seconded by Mr. Cook that Bylaw No. 7 be published in the Pembrok Observer for four weeks then taken into consideration next meeting of Council. Carried.

Mr. Graff gives notice that he will at the present sitting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of levying the Rates for the Township of Ross for the current year.

 Moved by Mr. Coak seconded by Mr. Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of Mr. Allan Land surveyor for the amount of ten dollars for surveying a New Road known as the Bulmer Road on lots 10 & 11 in the 9<sup>th</sup> con<sup>g</sup> of Ross and also for plan of said Road. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Cartman seconded by Mr. Graff that <sup>for laying the lots</sup> Bylaw No. 8 be brought up and read the first time. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Cartman seconded by Mr. Graff that Bylaw No. 8 be brought up and the first blank filled in with \$1878.59 and the second blank filled with Nine Mills then read a second and third time short and passed. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Graff seconded by Mr. Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$7.20 in favour of George M. Cartmill being Expenses of Reue Marshall & Allen to Pembroke in Re Marion vs. the Corporation of Ross. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Graff seconded by Mr. Cartman that Robert Bulmer receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$20.<sup>00</sup> for building a Bridge across Wark's Creek. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Coak seconded by Mr. Graff that this Council grant \$5.<sup>00</sup> to be Expended on the town line between Ross and that is near Jonas Smiths in building a culvert or otherwise making a ditch to take the water of the Road which ever will be thought preferable providing the Herioton Council grants the same amount. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Coak seconded by Mr. Murdoch that the Road Commissioner be instructed to give a job on James M. Larus Bridge job not to exceed \$15.<sup>00</sup> to be given out the beginning of next week. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Graff seconded by Mr. Cartman that Robert Allen be appointed as a fit and proper person to call the first School Meeting of Section No. 10 of Ross. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Graff seconded by Mr. Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of Metcalf & Metcalf for the sum of \$5.<sup>00</sup> for advice and Re Marion and Corporation of Ross. *Carried.*

Moved by Mr. Murdoch seconded by Mr. Graff that the sum of \$110.<sup>00</sup> be Levied and collected upon all the rateable property of

School Section No 2 Ross. also School Section No 4 the sum of \$190.<sup>00</sup> School Section No 5 \$252.<sup>00</sup> School Section No 6 the sum of \$400.<sup>00</sup> School Section No 7 \$170.<sup>00</sup> School Section No 8 \$160.<sup>00</sup> School Section No 9 the sum of \$165.<sup>00</sup> all to defray the expenses of the aforesaid sections. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Graff that John Howie be appointed Collector for the Township of Ross for 1879. Carried.

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr Cartman that the Road Commissioner be instructed to get the ditch on Tuffys Hill repaired also to get the hole on the Bridge repaired. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Murdoch that an order be drawn in favour of James M. Cagherly for the sum of \$6.<sup>00</sup> for paying James Allan R.L.S. for running a line between the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> concessions of Ross. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Graff that this Council grant Robert Murdoch \$3.<sup>30</sup> for finding the Surveyor in error in the survey of the Bulmer Road. Carried.

Moved by Mr Graff seconded by Mr Cartman that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the first Saturday in October next in Cobden. Carried.
