Treasurer for the sum of \$48.00 for collecting taxes
for the year 1879. Carried

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr
Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer
for the sum of \$18.42 in favour of S. C. Mitchell being
for stationery for the year 1874 to 79. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr
Humphries that an order be drawn on the Treasurer
for the sum fifty Cents in favor of James McAlister
for one day going to Beachburg to get Satchell made
for Assessing. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries
that an order be drawn in favor of Mr Thomas Deason for the
sum of \$2 for Advice. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Jamieson
that Henry Stokes receive an order on the Treasurer
for the sum of \$2.65 being for Leather Satchell for
assessor. Carried

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr
Jamieson that Richard Humphries and David Cook go

and Ascertain what Compensation the parties on the
disputed Gorman Line would want for improvements
made on said line and if they cannot ascertain
what they want for improvements then to make them
an offer.

adopted by this Council. Carried

On Motion of Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries
that James M. Alistair receive an order on the Treasurer
to the amount of \$35.⁶⁵ \$35.⁰⁰ being for salary and
sixty five cents being for paper and postage and
envelopes. Carried

On Motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Humphries
that John Cartman receive an order on the Treasurer for
the sum of \$4.²⁵ for Flour & Post given Mrs Mc
Naughton towards her support. Carried

On Motion of Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Cook
that James Johnston be employed by this Council to build
up the Bridge near Wainock's old place and also that he receive
one dollar after being inspected by Road Commissioner. Carried
