Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamison that Hugh Gilman be appointed Pound Keeper for the present year. "Carried"

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamison that Edward Jeffrey receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of three dollars for auditing acct. "Carried"

Moved by Mr Eastman seconded by Mr Jamieson that W. S. Coleman receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of three dollars for auditing Sp. Accts. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Humphries that the Road Inspector go and see the Road on the 2nd Con from Pass to Hunt Babon's and ascertain what it will cost to make it passable. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries that the Road Commissioner be instructed to notify David Ross James Arucland & Richard Freeland to remove their fences immediately as there is money to be expended this June on the Road or legal proceedings will be taken against them. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Deloma Brown for the amount of \$23.75 for work done on Forester's Falls Bridge. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries that one dollar be granted on the Road between James Logan and where Patrick Mahan done a job last summer on the fifth Con and part on the Road known as the Bush Road and also that the Road Commissioner be instructed to give notice and give out job site away. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries that \$10.⁰⁰ be granted to repair the Road leading to Haley's Station between Mr Oluustids and Ross's place and also that the Road Commissioner be instructed to give out the job of placing a culvert and also turnpiking the Road for the remainder of of the money and also that the Road Commissioner give notice as soon as possible. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Humphries that the Road Commissioner be instructed to go and see the Road on the fifth Concession from M^r Howards to the Proving line between 10 & 11 of Ross and ascertain what it will cost to spend out and Report at next meeting of Council. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Jamieson that this Council do pay the half of the expenses for writings that may be needed for a certain piece of Road through James Ross's place in lieu

of the Town line and also that the Clerk be instructed to notify the Westmeath Council to that effect. "Carried."

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries that this Council do appoint Delormia Brown to contract for six Scrapers of the large size in Kenfrew and also that he order shoes to save the handles and a chain in place of a Ball chain to be long enough when scraper is upset to clear the handle. "Carried."

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Jamieson that the C. & B. Co. move their wood immediately off the road at Clonabate Crossing. "Carried."

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Cook that Francis Crozier be appointed Pathmaster for the present year on the Gorman line from Thurmons to the Proving line between 20 & 21 and also to have charge of the Gorman road leading to the Queens Coat. "Carried."

Mr Cook gives notice that he will at the present meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of regulating the Statute labor according to the Enact on the apportionment for the year 1880. "Carried."

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamieson that Bylaw number 2 for the purpose of regulating the Statute labor for the year 1880 be brought up and read the first time. "Carried."

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Cartman that Bylaw No 2 for the purpose of regulating the Statute labor for the year 1880 be brought up and read the second & third time short & passed. "Carried"

The aforesaid Bylaw was read a first second and third time short and passed according to the above Resolutions.

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamieson that Roll Hill receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$30⁰⁰ part Salary for 1880. "Carried."

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamieson that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the first Saturday in August next. "Carried"
