

Town Hall Saturday ^{14th Aug} ~~July~~ 1850

Pursuant to Adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross Met in the Town Hall Cobble on Saturday the 4th August 1850.

Members all present The Reading of Minutes of former Meeting were read approved of and Signed by the Reue & Clerk.

On Motion of Mr. Humphris Seconded by Mr. James that an order be drawn in favor of Maurice McGinty for the sum of \$4.00 for his improvements on the Road allowance passing by Act of Sol No 21 in the 5th Con Sp. of Ross. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. Cook Seconded by Mr. James that James Ross receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$20.00 being for Road Allowance on Town line around Rock at his place as Equivalent to the Westmeath grant. "Carried"

Mr. Cook gives Notice that he will at the present sitting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of levying a Rate to meet and defray the Expenses of the current year. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. James Seconded by Mr. Cartman that Bylaw No 3 for the purpose of levying a Rate to meet and defray the Expenses of the current year be brought up and Read the first time. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. Cartman Seconded by Mr. James that Bylaw No 3 for the purpose of levying a Rate to meet and defray the Expenses of the current year be now brought up and Read the second & third time and passed. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. Cook Seconded by Mr. Cartman that James Hright be authorized to open a Water Course on the fifth Concession at Fletchers place and also to build a Condie on the Road and open a Water Course across the Road allowance work to be done ^{after} Harvest and give Credit on next years ~~last~~ Statute Labour. "Carried"

On Motion of Mr. Crook seconded by Mr. Humphries that \$10.00 be expended on the 5th con between Patrick Phelan and James Laganus and that the Road Commissioners give out a job of the same. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Cartman that \$10.00 be granted on the 2nd con between Foss and Huelletones to be laid out in stamping and also that the Road Commissioners be instructed to go and give out the job of stamping the same. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Humphries that the sum of \$60.00 be granted by this Council to be expended on the 6th con passing Lots 5 & 10. and that the Road Commissioners give out a job of clearing the said road. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Crook seconded by Mr. Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Robert Hill for amount of \$1.12 $\frac{1}{2}$ for Postage. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. ~~Cartman~~ ^{Cartman} that David Cook receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.50 for going to see the parties on the Gorman line and fifty Cents for getting scraper fixed total \$2.00. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Cartman seconded by Mr. Jamieson that Richard Humphries receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.50 for going to see the parties on the disputed Gorman line as regard settling with them ^{Carried}.

On Motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. ~~Cartman~~ ^{Cook} that \$2.00 be paid George M. Castile for drawing plans from Beachburg for Housler Falls Bridge. Carried.

On Motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Cartman that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the third Saturday in September next. Carried.
