 be taken after that date. "Carried."

Moved by Mr Jameson Seconded by Mr  
 Cartman that the Clerk be instructed to notify  
 John Gorman not to obstruct the road going  
 through his place leading to Healy's Station  
 as there is to be Public notice given to that State  
 - papers of the Sp. of Ross before it can be  
 legally closed. "Carried."

Moved by Mr Cartman Seconded by  
 Mr Jameson that this Council do now adjourn  
 to meet again on the Second Saturday in Novem-  
 -ber Next. "Carried"
