Moved by Mr. Cartman seconded by Mr. Cooks that the Revere George McCastill and Councillor Wm Jamieson be appointed by this Council to draw a Plan or Specification of a Bridge at Foresters Falls. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Humphries seconded by Mr. Jamieson that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on Saturday the 11th day of December 1850. Carried.

Cobden Town Hall Decr 11th 1850

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall Cobden on Saturday the 11th day of December 1850.

a full Council present, the Revere presiding
Minutes of former Meeting were read approved of and signed by the Revere and Clerk

A Petition was read from Mrs. McFetters and others praying the Council would grant Money to open up the Town line between Horton & Ross from Goulds Road to the Jones Road.

Moved by Mr. Cook seconded by Mr. Jamieson that ten dollars be granted by this Council to be Expended on the Town line between Horton & Ross that is from Goulds Road to the Jones Road, providing Horton Council grant the same as petitioned for by Mrs. McFetters and others. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Cartman that Michael Fletcher receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$8.00 for work done on Roads. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Cook, Seconded by Mr. Humphries that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Alex Bell for the sum of \$11.⁰⁰ for Repairing Road Scrapers. Carried

Moved by Mr. Cartman, Seconded by Mr. Jamieson that the Widow McGinty be exempt from half the Tax and Poor Rates for the year 1880, also that the Widow Dellabough be exempt from the County & Township Rates for 1880. Carried

Moved by Mr. Cook, Seconded by Mr. Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$15.⁰⁰ in favor of William Brown for work done on Town line between Bromley and Ross. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson, Seconded by Mr. Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$7.⁵⁷ due School Section No 3 being balance due over their application. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Cartman, Seconded by Mr. Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$9.⁰⁰ in favor of Patrick McHale for work done on the 5th Con of Ross Barriels.

Moved by Mr. Cook, Seconded by Mr. Jamieson that John Howie receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$3.⁵⁹ being for the exemption of Mrs. Dellabough's and Mrs. McGinty's Taxes. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson, Seconded by Mr. Cook that William McLeese be exempt from County & Township Taxes for the year 1880 on the Grist-Mill. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Humphries, Seconded by Mr. Cartman that Meloma Brown receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$10.⁰⁰ being his Salary as Road Commissioner for 1880. Carried

Moved by Mr. Humphries, Seconded by Mr. Cartman that W. S. Marshall receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$3.³⁸ for Stationery & Wood. Carried

Moved by Mr. Jamieson, Seconded by Mr. Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$13.⁵⁰ in favour of the Pembroke Observer for printing Nominations Notices Ballot papers & Minutes for 1880. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Cook and Seconded by Mr. Humphries that Mr. W. S. Campbell's Tender be accepted for the building of the Bridge at Foresters Falls providing that he furnishes Alex

- Hudson and James Little as Sureties for the amount of \$1800.⁰⁰ the amount of his tender being \$900.⁰⁰ (Carried)

Moved by Mr Jamison Seconded by Mr Cartman that Daniel Holt be appointed Inspector to inspect the works on the Bridge at Foresters Halls and that he get \$1.²⁵ per day on Conditions that he furnishes security for the amount of \$900.⁰⁰ and that his time begins when the building commences. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook Seconded by Mr Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the amount of \$30.⁰⁰ being balance of salary for Robt Hill as Clerk for 1880. Carried

Moved by Mr Humphries Seconded by Mr Cook that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the following amounts viz George M Castille for his services as Revd \$16.⁵⁰ William Jamison for his services as Councillor the sum of \$16.⁵⁰ John Cartman for his services as Councillor the sum of \$15.⁰⁰ for his services as Councillor David Cook the sum of 15.⁰⁰ " " " " " " Richard Humphries " " " " " " " " all the above sums being for the year 1880. Carried.
