

Council Room Mar 5th/81

Pursuant to adjournment - the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall Cobden on Saturday the 5th March 1881.

Members all present except the Reeve he being absent. It was moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Cartman that David Cook take the Chair in the absence of the Reeve Geo M. Castle.

Minutes of former Meeting were read approved of and signed by Chairman & Clerk.

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamieson that an order be drawn in favor of John Howie for the sum of \$46.95 for Mustills in Norman Byces & Mrs McInty's Taxes. Carried.

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Jamieson that John Howie receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$48.00 being salary for collecting Taxes for the year 1880.

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Cartman that the Justices of P.S. No 3 receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.40 being due that Section through mistake. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamieson that \$4.60 be struck off Norman Byces Taxes it being an error in non-resident land charged against him. Carried.

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.00 in favour of Peter Ponder for drawing Petition to Government for Money for Forsters Falls Bridge. Carried.

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Jamieson that the Pembroke Standard do the printing for Ross Council for the year 1881. it being the lowest tender. Carried.

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Humphries that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$2.10 in favour of the Cobden Post Office for Postage. Carried.

Moved by Mr Jamison seconded by Mr. [unclear] that the Clerk be instructed to give public notice of a Bylaw to be passed at the next meeting of Council on the ~~first~~ Second Saturday in April 1887 for the purpose of changing a certain piece of Road leading to Haleso Station from lot 21 to line between 22 & 23. Council

Moved by Mr Humphris seconded by Mr. Cartman that the sum of \$20.00 be expended on the disputed Gorman line between the old Goulds line & proof line between 20 & 21 & that the Road Commissioner be instructed to expend the same. Council

Moved by Mr Jamison seconded by Mr. Cartman that M. S. Coleman receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$0.33 being for paper & spikes. Council

Moved by Mr Jamison seconded by Mr. Cartman that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the ~~first~~ Second Saturday in April. Council
