A full Council present the Reeve presiding
Minutes of former Meeting were Read approved of and signed by the Reeve & Clerk

Mr Cook gives notice that he will at the present sitting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the purpose of closing up a certain piece of Road across John Gorman's land and removing it to the side line between lots 22 & 23.

Moved by Mr. Humphries Seconded by Mr. Cook that Bylaw No 4 for the purpose of Closing up a Road across John Gorman's land and removing it to the side line between lots 22 & 23.

Carried.
there was then a Petition put before the Council forbidding the Closing up of the said Road and no more action was taken upon it.

Mr. Humphries gives notice that he will at the present meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw for the payment of certain sums of money mentioned therein.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson Seconded by Mr. Cartman that the above tender be accepted for printing the Minutes and auditors abstract for the year 1881.

Moved by Mr. Cook Seconded by Mr. Humphries that ~~an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the~~ Eight dollars be granted towards the support of Martin Gorman and also that Mrs. Loner be allowed to expend the same and present a bill to this Council.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson Seconded by Mr. Humphries that the Road Commissioner be instructed to examine the Road near James M. Laughlan's on proof line between lots 20 & 21 on the 6th Concession and Report the Condition of the Road at next Meeting of Council.

Moved by Mr. Cook Seconded by Mr. Humphries that the Road Commissioner be instructed to go and examine the Bridge on the Road leading to the Garden Settlement.

Moved by Mr Cook Seconded by Mr Humphreus that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Alex Hudson to the amount of \$405.⁰⁰ being for remainder of payment on Foresters Falls Bridge and also for extras as reported by Bridge inspector. Lost &

Moved by Mr Jamieson Seconded by Mr Cartman that Alex Hudson receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$425.⁰⁰ being balance due on Bridge and Extras as reported by inspector. Carried.

R. Moved by Mr Cook Seconded by Mr Humphreus that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Daniel Holt to the amount of \$66.²⁵ for fifty three days work inspecting Foresters Falls Bridge. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cook Seconded by Mr Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Roll Holt for the sum of \$3.²⁵ for one Hundred weight of Flour and delivering it to Mrs McNaughton. Carried.
