Pursuant to Notice published in the Pembroke Standard the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall Cobden on the aforesaid date as a Court of Revision.

The Members all having taken the necessary oath of office took their seats the Court opened according to the Statute in such cases provided for.

The following are the appeals that was made viz

1st John Sammon. Too high assessed on Real property
2nd John Delahey " " assessed on Lot No 6 & 7 in the 2nd Concession of the Township of Ross.

Moved by Mr. Cartman Seconded by Mr. Jamieson that 15 per cent be struck off John Delahey's assessment on lots No 6 & 7 in the 1st & 2nd Con of Ross. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Cartman Seconded by Mr. Jamieson that Village lots Nos 341-342-344-345 & 346 be struck off Carter's assessment and added to John McCays. Carried.

Moved by Mr. Jamieson Seconded by Mr. Cartman that James McLeans name be struck off the Roll and John Moore inserted instead. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cook Seconded by Mr Jamieson that Robert Stewart's name be struck off the Roll and Samuel Rankins inserted instead. Carried.

Moved by Mr Jamieson Secouded by Mr Cartman that Edward Gibson be allowed his Statute Labor to make a Culvert across the Road at lot No 5 on the 3rd Co for the present Year. Carried

Moved by Mr Cook Secouded by Mr Jameson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Alex Wadsworth for the sum of \$7.⁰⁰ for building a Bridge on Road leading to the Garden Settlement. Carried

Moved by Mr Humphries Secouded by Mr Jameson that \$10.⁰⁰ be expended on the 2nd Co near William Huckabones. Carried

Moved by Mr Jameson Secouded by Mr Cartman that \$20.⁰⁰ be Expended on the 6th Co Line between lots No 2 14 in Said Concession and that the Road Commissioner be instructed to Expand the Same. Carried
