Moved by Mr Jameson Seconded by Mr Cartman that the Reading of Minutes of Council be postponed until the next Regular Meeting of Council. "Carried"

Moved by Mr Humphris Seconded by Mr Cook that Mr Wm Walker Road Surveyor of the Township of Admaston be authorized to run that portion of the Douglas and Halsey Station Road from the Town line between the Townships of Ross & Admaston and Halsey's Station that the Clerk on receipt of his Report give the necessary notices as the law directs that it is the intention of this Council to pass a Bylaw at its next sitting establishing the said portion of Road in accordance with the Surveyors Report, and that the Clerk be instructed to notify Mr Walker of his appointment.

Moved by Mr Cook Seconded by Mr Jameson (Carried) that the Clerk be instructed to notify Delorna Brown Road Commissioner to meet William Walker Road Surveyor for Admaston at the Town line between Ross and Admaston at or about the proposed crossing of the Douglas and Halsey Station Road on Thursday the 16th day of June at the hour of ten o'clock A.M. for the purpose of surveying that part of the Road to Halsey Station. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Jameson Seconded by Mr Humphris that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.00 in favor of James Humphris for fixing Road Scrapers. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Cartman Seconded by Mr Jameson that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the first Monday in

August meet at the hour of ten o'clock in
