Moved by Mr Cook Jameson seconded by Mr Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Robert Dever for the sum of \$30.00 for allowance of Road running through lot No 23 in the 1st Concession of Ross. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Cook that By Law No 10 for the purpose of paying certain sums of money mentioned therein be now brought up and read the first time Carried

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries that By Law No 10 for the purpose of paying certain sums of money be now brought up and read the 2nd & third time short & passed. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Cook seconded by Mr Humphries that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the last Saturday of October at the hour of 10 o'clock AM. (Carried)
