Town Hall Cobden March 23

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Town Hall Cobden on the 25th day February 1882 (The Recorder being absent it was moved & resolved that David Cook take the Chair) Minutes of former Meeting were read approved of & signed by the ~~Pres~~ Chairman. & Clerk

Mr Humphries gives notice that he will at the present sitting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of paying certain sums of money.

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by John Cartman that the Widow Dellabough & Mrs McGinty be exempt from Taxes for the the year 1881. Mrs Dellabough \$1.40 & Mrs McGinty \$1.00 and that John Hawn receive an order for the same

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of John Hawn for the sum of \$53.00 being the amount of salary for collecting for the year 1881.

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Humphries that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$2.03 in favor of Edward Gibson for taxes paid in error.

(Carried)

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Wm Jamieson for the sum of \$7.00 for payment of Coffin & Burying an unknown man found dead in this Township also \$1.00 for his trouble.

(Carried)

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$2.21 in favor of Cobden Post Office for Postage &c. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$22.00 being the amount of the Contract with the Pembroke Standard for the year 1881.

(Carried)

Moved by Mr Humphris seconded by Mr Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$856 being overplus over their application in S.S. No 4 Sp. Ross. Carried.

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Cartman that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.78 in favor of S.S. No 5 Sp. Ross being the amount over their application for said Section. Carried.

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Cartman that the Municipal Council of the Township of the Township of Ross do hereby exempt from all taxes for the term of ten years from January last the lands and premises purchased by George Curtis of the City of Utica N.Y. (Banker) from Daniel Tierney of Perth Ala Masie of Cobden and Robert Crawford of the Sp. of Westville. The said premises are situated between Main, Pimblet & Cawley Streets in the village of Cobden, also all stock in trade and buildings to be erected and used on said premises for any and all Milling or Manufacturing purposes also all Machinery required for Manufacturing or other purposes required to be used on said land or premises by the Company known or to be known as the Ontario Land Milling, Mining, Wood pulp Match and Paper Manufacturing Company we hereby agree to exempt the above named Company from all taxes as above mentioned in consideration of the said Company raising said buildings and Machinery for Manufacturing purposes when completed. Carried.

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Humphris that the Road Commissioner be instructed along with Mr Mr Jamieson to find out the best Site of Road as petitioned for by John Howie & others. Carried.

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Humphris that the Clerk be authorized to write to the Commissioner of Crown Lands Toronto and ascertain if any person is holding claim on lot No 27 in the 7th Con. Sp. of Ross. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Jamieson and Seconded by Mr Cartman
that By-Law for paying certain sums of money
be now brought up and read the first time, (Carried)

Moved by Mr Cartman Seconded by Mr Humphris
that By-Law for the purpose of paying certain sums
of money be now brought up and read the second
and third time short & passed. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Jamieson Seconded by Mr Cartman
that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on
the last Saturday in March at the hour of Ten
o'clock A.M. (Carried)
