It was moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Humphries that David Cook take the Chair in the absence of the Rev Geo McCash (Carried)

Mr Humphries gives notice that he will at the present sitting of Council introduce a By Law for the purpose of paying certain sums of money mentioned therein.

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer for the sum of \$30.00 in favor James McAlister for his services as a assessor for the Township of Ross for the year 1882. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Jamieson that the Tender to Observer's tender be accepted for the Municipal Printing for the year 1882, it being the lowest tender. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Cartman that the Road Commissioners be instructed to go and give out a job of Brushing and repairing on the Road leading from Joe Gaulds to Halcy Station Anson as the Hay Road Grant not to exceed twenty five dollars. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Pembroke observer for the sum of \$13.30 for Printing Minutes of Council and advertising Contract for Bridge at Forsters Falls. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Jamieson that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of D Brown for the sum of \$2.50 for getting gully on the East side of Westport. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Jameson seconded by Mr Cartman that the Clerk be instructed to notify Michael Gorman<sup>sr</sup> to remove his fences off the 5<sup>th</sup> Cou. and leave the line open for travel opposite lots No<sup>s</sup> 21, 22 & 23 according to Bond with the Township. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Humphries seconded by Mr Jameson that David Cook order Six Road Scrapers for the use of the Township. (Carried)

Moved by Mr Cartman seconded by Mr Jameson that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the first Saturday in May next then meet as a Court of Revision and other business. (Carried)
