

Cobden Townhall October 14th 1882

Pursuant to Agreement
The Municipal Council of the Township of Hills Dale in
the town hall Cobden on the aforesaid day the members
all present the Deem Mr. Mr. Eskill in the Chair the
Minutes of former meeting read and approved of
and signed by the Deem and Clerk

Moved by Mr. Cook and seconded by Mr. Humphreys
that the Clerk be instructed to instruct
the Road Commission to let a job of repaving the
road on the fourth Course river line in front of
lots nine and ten as petitioned for by Henry Elliott
and others the job not to exceed ten dollars

Carried
Moved by William Jamison and seconded by Richard
Humphreys that no action be taken on Alexander
Hudsons petition at present

Carried
Moved by Mr. Humphreys and seconded by Mr. Jamison
that a order be drawn on the treasury in favour
of James Logan for the sum of ten dollars for
work performed on the fifth Cor line

Carried
Moved by Mr. Cook and seconded by Mr. Cartman that
a order be drawn on the treasury for the sum of
seven dollars in favour of Benjamin McEwen being
the amount in full for building a bridge

Carried
Moved by Mr. Cook and seconded by Mr. Humphreys
that a order be drawn on the treasury in favour of
Thos. Elliott for the sum of \$25 for labour done
on proclime between lots 5 & 6

Carried

Moved by Mr. Humphreys and second by Mr. Cook that
a credit be drawn on the treasury for the sum of \$19.76
in favor of Hart and Co. for Stationery

Moved by Mr. Jamison and second by Mr. Cartman
that five dollars be expended in repairing the road in
front of Cobden Postoffice and that the road Commission
be authorized to expend the same

Moved by Mr. Cook and second by Mr. Humphreys
that the clerk be instructed to authorize the road
Commissioners to let out a job of building a bridge
across Bottoms gully on the Duane Road

Moved by Mr. Cook and second by Mr. Jamison
that this Council do now adjourn to meet again
on the third Saturday in December 1884
