Moved by Mr. Humphreys and seconded by Mr. Cook that James Goulds personal property be struck off the roll and the real estate now assessed to James Goulds be assessed to Isaac Miller

Moved by Mr. Cook and seconded by Mr. Humphreys that the rolls be captioned as revised and that this Court do now close and open for the general business of the township

Moved by Mr. Cook and seconded by Mr. Jamison that the road Commission be instructed to give a job of crosslaying on Cox line between the 5 & 6 con between Mr. Smith and Mr. Crothers

Moved by Mr. Jamison and seconded by Mr. Cook that the statutory labour for the present be as follows  
 that two <sup>days</sup> labour be charged against all persons assessed on road for property also all valued 600 & days 900-4 days 1200 & days and four hundred over had one additional day Carried

Moved by Mr. Cook and seconded by Mr. Jamison that James Faver be allowed 12 days statutory labour on the second Cox line in front of his own property Carried

Moved by Mr. Castman and seconded by Mr. Jamison that the Road Commission be instructed to expend the sum of 25 dollars in building a bridge & cutting the banks on Burnett's Creek on proo line between lots 5 & 6

Moved by Mr. Cook and seconded by Mr. Jamison that John C. [unclear] and George Ross be allowed their stipulated labour on con line between 5 & 6 range opposite lot no 10

Moved by Mr. Jamison and seconded by Mr. Castman that this Court do now adjourn to meet again on the first Saturday in August

Moved by Mr. Jamison and seconded by Mr. Cook that ten dollars be expended on the town line between W. Ross & Bromley opposite lot no 14 in 1 con
