

Townhall Cobden August 4th 1853

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross Met in the townhall Cobden on the above mentioned day the Mr. Mr. Caspell in the Chair and all the members present

Mr. Humphreys gives notice that he will at this present sitting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses of the County and Township for the present year

Moved by Mr. Humphreys and seconded by Mr. Cameron that bylaw No. 8 for the purpose of levying and collecting a certain sum of money sufficient to defray the necessary expenses of the County and Township for the present year be brought up and read a first time

Bylaw No. 8 was brought up and read a first time

Moved by Mr. Cook and seconded by Mr. Eastman that bylaw No. 8 be brought up and read a second and third time short and passed

Mr. Cook gives notice that he will at this present sitting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money mentioned therein

Moved by Mr. Humphreys and seconded by Mr. Eastman that bylaw No. 8 be brought up and read a first time

Bylaw No. 8 was brought up and read a first time

Moved by Mr. Eastman and seconded by Mr. Cook that bylaw No. 8 be brought up and read a second time and that the blanks be filled up with the amount in following viz: George Peterson for labor done

Carried by Mr. Bradman that bylaw No 8 be brought ^{in payment of money} and read a third time short and passed Carried bylaw No 8 was brought up and read a third time moved by Mr. Jamison and second by Mr. Humphreys that Mr. Peter Hammiton receive a order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$1.50 for statute labour charged on roll which was performed

Carried Moved by Mr. Jamison and second by Mr. Humphreys that William Gould be allowed to perform his statute labour for three years on Con line between 7th & 8th range Carried moved by Mr. Humphreys and second by Mr. Cook that \$10 be granted to be expended near Hailys station in ditching and that the Road Commissioner be instructed to expend the same

Carried Moved by Mr. Cook and second by Mr. Jamison that the Clerk be instructed to notify John Thompson Wm Row Abraham Tushen and Robert Bradman to remove their fences off the Con line between the 7th & 8th range

Carried Moved by Mr. Cook and second by Mr. Humphreys that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the last Saturday in September Carried
