Pursuant to Adjournment the Municipal Council of the township of Ross met in the town hall Cobden on the above mentioned day Mr Jamison Mr Cook and Humphers present Mr Eastman and the few absent  
Moved by Mr Cook and second by Mr Humphers that Mr Jamison take the Chair

Minutes of former Meeting read approved and signed by the Chairman and Clerk Mr Humphers gives notice that will at this present sitting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money entered therein

Moved by Mr Cook and second by Mr Humphers that bylaw No 9 be brought and read a first time

Bylaw No 9 was brought up and read a first time

 his property also to notify Mr. Duncan Stewart  
 & line Horton that he is appointed by the  
 Council to value the same Carried

 that the job of repairing the con line between 6th & 6th  
 range near Mr. Francis's crosses be left over  
 until next sitting of Council Carried
