

Town Hall Cobden August 30<sup>th</sup> 1884

Pursuant to adjournment the Municipal Council of the township of Ross met in the town hall Cobden on the above mentioned day councilors all present the Asses Mr. Mc. Cashell absent. Moved, by Mr. Mc. Alister and seconded by Mr. Humphreys that Mr. Jamison take the Chair. Mr. Jamison took the Chair after which the minutes of former meeting were read approved and signed by the Chairman and Clerk. Moved by Mr. Alister and seconded by Mr. Humphreys that bylaw No 5 for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money be brought up and read a first time. Carried. Bylaw No 5 was brought up and read a first time. Mr. Delaney gives notice that he will at this present sitting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of giving a rate sufficient to defray the necessary expenses of the current year. Moved by Mr. Humphreys and seconded by Mr. Delaney that bylaw No 6 for the purpose of giving a rate sufficient to defray the necessary expenses of the township for the current year be brought up and read a first time. Carried. Bylaw No 6 was brought and read a first time. Moved by Mr. Humphreys and seconded by Mr. Mc. Alister that bylaw No 5 for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money be brought up and a second and third time short and passed and that the blanks be filled in with the different amounts as follows and that orders be drawn on the treasurer for the same carried.
