Townhall Cobden January 19th 1845

The Municipal Council of the township of Ross
met in the town hall Cobden on the above mentioned
day the Privie Mr. Mr. Caskill Councilor, Mr.
Walter Garrison Humphreys & Delaney after
taking the necessary oath of office and signing
the declaration of the same each member took
his seat, Mr. Delaney gives notice that he
will at this present sitting of Council
introduce a bylaw for the purpose of appo-
inting township officers to fill the different
offices in the township for the present year.

Moved by Mr. Garrison and seconded by Mr.
Delaney that bylaw was for the purpose of
appointing township officers be brought up
and read a first time. Carried
Bylaw was brought up and read a
first time.

Moved by Mr. Delaney and seconded by Mr. Mr.
Custer that bylaw was for the purpose of
appointing officers for the present year be
brought up and read a second time and that
the blanks be filled up with the different
names as follows namely John Reynolds Clerk
Salary \$ 75 John Mc Ghee Receiver Salary \$ 50
John Howie Collector Salary \$ 50

Moved by Mr. McAlister and seconded by Mr. Humphreys that a order be drawn on the treasurer in favour of John Campbell for the sum of two dollars for repairing of a scaper carried

Moved by Mr. Delahay and seconded by Mr. Jamison that a order be drawn on the treasurer in favour of John Howie for eighteen dollars for labour charges on roll which was performed also for repairing a scaper carried

Moved by Mr. Jamison and seconded by Mr. McAlister that a order be drawn on the treasurer in favour of John Reynolds for the sum of six dollars to pay the Sanitary Committee carried

Moved by Mr. Jamison and seconded by Mr. McAlister that a order be drawn on the treasurer in favour of George M. Callum for the sum of two dollars for repairing Culvert carried

Moved by Mr. Jamison and seconded by Mr. Delahay that this Council do advise the Board to meet again on the second of December in March carried

Moved by Mr. Delahay and seconded by Mr. Jamison that the time for the return of the collectors rolls be extended until the first of March next carried
