 Not to exceed \$1.60
 Road line between lots 10 & 11 from Malcolm Morrison's to Chase factory
 Not to exceed \$15.00
 Road from Chase factory to Mr. Byers Curving Mill
 Not to exceed \$35.00 & also
 Bridge at Almsteads Mills
 Not to exceed \$7.00

Moved by Mr. Jamison and second by Mr. Humphreys that Mr. Delhey get town hall painted, and repaired to grade around the hall and have a water closet built
 carried

Moved by Mr. Delhey and second by Mr. M^r. Alister that this council do now adjourn to meet again on the first Saturday in August
