Moved by Mr. DeLaney & second by Mr. Jamison that the road commissioner be instructed to examine the bridge at Round Monroes and report condition of same at next meeting of council carried

Moved by Mr. Jamison & second by Mr. Alistair that Round Monroes be allowed to perform his labour on line in front of lot 14 carried

Moved by Mr. Humphers & second by Mr. DeLaney that the sum of eight dollars be expended on profling between 20 & 21 in 15 con in blasting rocks carried

Moved by Mr. DeLaney & second by Mr. Jamison that the road com inspect the bridge on road leading in to Robert Johnson and report the same at next meeting of council carried

Moved by Mr. Humphers & second by Mr. Alistair that the clerk be instructed to notify Tho. Wallace to remove his fence off the blank con between ranges 5 & 6 in front of lots 18 & 19 carried

Moved by Mr. DeLaney & second by Mr. Humphers that by law No 11 for the purpose of levying a sufficient sum of money to defray the necessary expenses of the township for the present year be brought up and read a third time short-ord passed. By Law No 11 was brought up and read a third time short-ord passed carried
