Moved by Mr. Mc Alister and second by Mr. Humphreys that bylaw No 16 for purpose of paying out certain sums of money entered therein be brought up and read a first time

Moved by Mr. Jamison and second by Mr. Mc Alister that bylaw No 16 be brought up and read a second time and that the blanks be filled in with the different amounts as follows and orders be drawn on the treasury for the same:

John Howie for collecting taxes 1885 £ 50. 25 John Reynolds for collectors receipts and schedules 4. 10 John Mc Ginn for assessing 1886 £ 45. 70

Moved by Mr Jamison and second by Mr McAlister that Mr Henry Boyce be appointed Road Com. for the present year at a salary of \$25 Carried

Moved by Mr McAlister and second by Mr Humphreys that the Clerk be instructed to notify the road com. to examine the proof line between 20 and 21 in 5th Con and survey a road round a certain rock on said line and report at next sitting of Council Carried

Moved by Mr Delaney and second by Mr Humphreys that the Clerk be instructed to notify Thomas Mathison and William Black to remove their fences off the road between lots 5 & 6 Carried

Moved by Mr Delaney and second by Mr Humphreys that bylaw No 16 be brought up and read a third time short and passed Carried

Moved by Mr Jamison and second by Mr Delaney that as school sections No 5, 6 & 4 has at the public school meetings held for the purpose of considering the changing of the boundaries of said sections as proposed by the petitions of Duncan McMartin Isaac Miller and James Hendrick and others have by large majorities decided against the proposed change and that as sections No 4 & 5 have erected new school houses this Council do not deem it advisable to make any change in the boundaries of said sections at present Carried

Moved by Mr Delaney and second by Mr McAlister that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the first Saturday in May at a court of session and general business Carried
