

Calden Town hall June 26th 1886

Pursuant to adjournment the municipal Council of the township of Ross Mt in the town hall Caldun on the above mentioned day the Rev Mr M: Puskill in the chair, Councilors all present. Minutes of former meeting read approved of and signed by the Rev and clerk.

Mr Jamison gives notice that he will at this present sitting of Council introduce a bylaw for the paying out certain sums of money & entered therein moved by Mr Jamison and second by Mr Delehey that bylaw No 17 be brought up and read a first time, carried. Bylaw No 17 was brought up and read a first time.

Mr Delehey gives notice that he will at this present sitting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of establishing a road round a certain rock on proof line between 20 and 21 in the 5 con. moved by Mr Delehey and second by Mr M: Alistair that bylaw No 18 be brought up and read a first time <sup>in the</sup> carried.

Bylaw No 18 was brought up and read a first time. Mr Humphreys gives notice that he will at this present sitting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of establishing said road, <sup>and</sup> moved by Mr Humphreys and second by Mr M: Alistair that bylaw No 19 be brought up and read a first time for the purpose of establishing said road, carried.

Bylaw No 19 was brought up and read a first time. Moved by Mr M: Alistair and by Mr Delehey that bylaw No 18 be brought up and read a second and third time short and passed.

Bylaw No 18 was brought up and read a second and third time short and passed.

Moved by Mr Jamison and second by Mr Humphrey that bylaw No 19 be brought up and read a second and third time short and passed carried

Moved by Mr Humphrey and second by Mr M<sup>r</sup> Alister that the clerk be instructed to have the con. line between the 3 and 4 range & M. L. run from the town line between Wilmouth and Ross to proof line between 5 & 6 carried

Moved by Mr Jamison and second by Mr Humphrey that the road Com. be instructed to inspect the bridge across the Mill creek at Mr A Almsteads, also the bridge near Mr Jamisons Lime Hill, and that part of the con. line near Mr M Nevils, and the bridge on the Queens road at Mr S Ranklins and have the necessary repairs performed carried

Moved by Mr Jamison and second by Mr Humphrey that bylaw No 17 be brought up and read a second and third time and that the blanks be filled in with the different amounts as follows. Charles Mr Ginty pay for limber for road also work performed on said road P. 20. 00

Duncan Mr Ewen for surveying town line P. 5. 00

To James Oliver for services for bridge . 10 . 00

To Richard Crozier for repairing scrapers 1 60
