Moved by Mr. Delahay and second by Mr. Jamison that the order be authorized to settle the arrear of taxes with the County Treasurer for lots in the village of Cobden and described 5 acres being part of lot 5 in 1 con in the township of Ross said lots not being properly described and were sold by the Co. Treasurer last January in default of back taxes carried.
